

MASTER'S AND DOCTORATE PROGRAM IN CHEMISTRY – UEL

NORMATIVE ACT N° 003/2020

Establishes the criteria for changing level from master's to Doctorate, without the dissertation defense

THE COORDINATION OF THE MASTER'S AND DOCTORATE COURSE IN CHEMISTRY OF UEL, in the use of its legal attributions and in accordance with CEPE Resolution N° 025/2016

ESTABLISHES

Art. 1º Criteria for changing level from master's to Doctorate, without the dissertation defense,

§ 1º - The student at the master's level of the chemistry graduate program, as well as his supervisor, must express the interest in changing from the master's level to the doctorate level by writing the justification to the coordination.

§ 2º - The student of the Chemistry Graduate Program at the Master's level must have fulfilled all credits according to the resolution - PPG *Stricto sensu* Collegiate No 011/2018, as well as the credits related to Dissertation I, II and III;

§ 3º - The student's academic record in the Chemistry Graduate Program at the Master's level should not present any failures in subjects.

§ 4º - The student of the Chemistry Graduate Program at the Master's level must defend a doctorate research project for an examining board consisting of 2 (two) professors from the Graduate Program in Chemistry and 1 (one) member outside the program with knowledge on the subject matter of the project;

§ 5º - The student must deliver the project copies to the examining board **15 days** in advance of the project's defense date;

§ 6º - The presentation of the project will consist of a verbal presentation of a minimum of 30 (thirty) minutes and a maximum of 40 (forty) minutes;

§ 7º - The appointment of the members of the examining board must be made by the supervisor and approved by the coordination;

§ 8º - The supervisor's participation during the defense of the research project will be prohibited to the examining board;

§ 9º - The student must be judged for 30 (thirty) minutes by each member of the examining board and approved, unanimously or by the majority of the members of the Board;
